Welcome Coadjutor Archbishop John Nienstedt!

This week on the anniversary of his installation as Supreme Pontiff, Pope Benedict XVI appointed the Most Reverend John C. Nienstedt as Coadjutor Archbishop of Saint Paul and Minneapolis. This means that he will become our chief shepherd in just over a year when our beloved Archbishop Flynn reaches the retirement age for bishops of 75 years old.

Archbishop Nienstedt was born and raised in Detroit. He served there as a pastor, rector of the seminary, and vicar general. He has a doctorate in moral theology and specializes in the field of biomedical ethics. He was made an auxiliary bishop in Detroit before being sent to New Ulm six years ago as bishop. He has enjoyed being able to minister in country parishes where he can get to know people well—this particular aspect will be a challenge in our large metropolitan area.

Archbishop Flynn still remains our spiritual guide. We have been so edified by his prayerful and joyful presence these past dozen years! This appointment brings great support to him in his last year as archbishop. He and Bishop Pates have been working more hours with less help since the departure of Bishop Campbell for Columbus and the death of dear Bishop Dudley. Now they are blessed with the addition of a capable and scholarly man of God to continue the good work that they tirelessly accomplish each day for the good of souls.
