## Holy Mass: Some Reminders

I want to take this opportunity to remind all of us of some very important points regarding the Sacred Liturgy and the way in which we participate at Holy Mass.

1. **Remember to dress the part.** No one with any sense would wear shorts and a tank top to a wedding or to a funeral. Our clothes signify the importance and gravity of what we are doing. Please dress appropriately for Holy Mass.
2. **No cell phones, snacking, or conversations.** Please try to be respectful of the sacred character of the Liturgy and of your neighbor's desire to pray. Please try to minimize any behavior that would distract from the Sacrifice of the Mass.
3. **Holy Communion should not be received by those in grave sin.** Please remember that those who are conscious of committing grave sin should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until they are able to receive Sacramental absolution. **Missing Mass without a good reason is a grave sin.** Examples of a good reason include serious illness or unforeseen transportation difficulties. If you are a parent with dependent children, please remember that by not coming to Mass you are also inhibiting your children from attendance at this most important prayer. If for some reason you cannot make it to St. Vincent's on a given weekend, please make plans to attend somewhere else.
4. **Confessions are available every Sunday from 8am – 8:45am.** If you need to make a confession so that you are able to receive Holy Communion, the Sacrament of Reconciliation is always available on Sunday mornings from 8 – 8:45. In addition to this time, confessions are also available at the Cathedral from 4pm until 5pm Monday through Friday and on Saturdays from 3:30pm until 5pm.
5. **Treat the Blessed Sacrament with the reverence He deserves.** Remember – it is Jesus Himself that you receive in Holy Communion. Regardless of whether you receive Him on the tongue

or on the hand, kneeling or standing, try to remember what you are doing as you wait to receive. Holy Communion should be consumed at the communion rail, not as you are walking back to your seat. If you are holding small children, I would recommend that you receive on the tongue in order to avoid dropping the Sacred Host. If you choose to receive on the hand, please try to make certain that your hand is clean out of respect for Christ. Under no circumstances should there be anything else in your mouth when you receive our Lord.

May God open our eyes so that we might recognize every week the awesome event that is the Holy Mass.
